- Have a quick shower not a bath – five to ten minutes is enough.

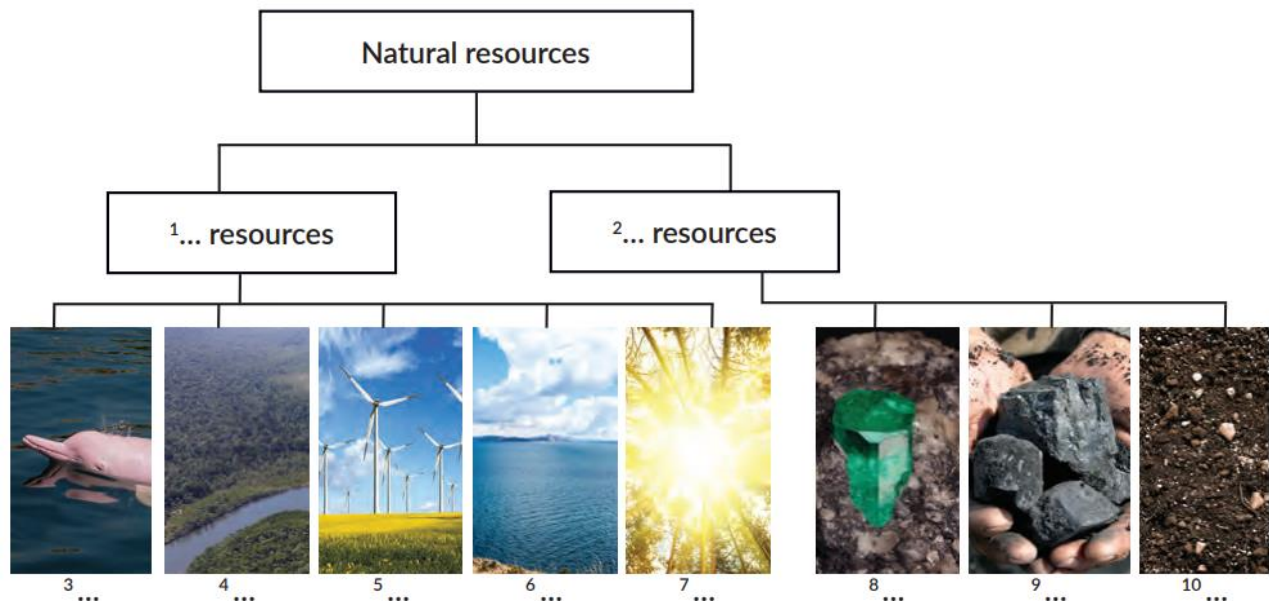

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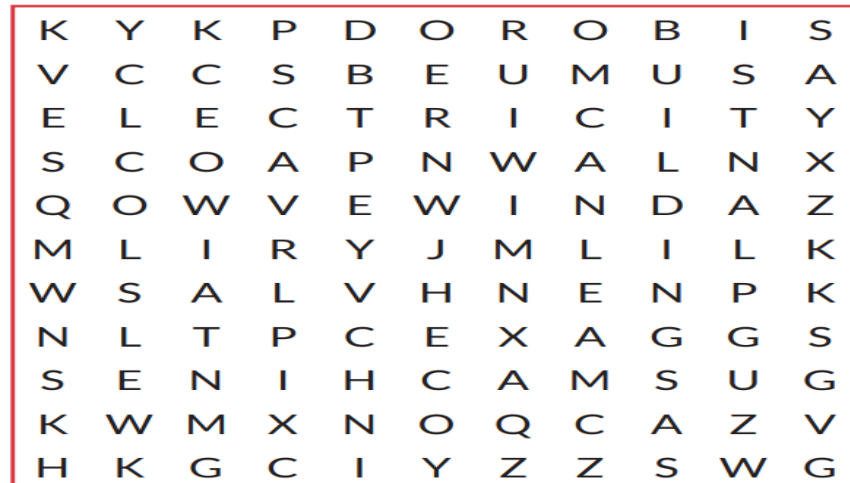


Natural resources come from nature and humans cannot create them. There are two categories: renewable and non-renewable.
